NATIONAL WORKERS' COMP LAW FIRM BOOSTS HARVEY RELIEF IN HOUSTON WITH DONATION TO HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Effort by Adelson, Testan, Brundo, Novell & Jimenez Part of Firm's National Community Support Program

AUSTIN, January 25, 2018 – Inspired by the work of its Austin-based attorney Elliott Klein, Adelson, Testan, Brundo, Novell & Jimenez (ATB), a leading workers' compensation defense law firm, recently made a \$5,000 donation to Houston Habitat for Humanity to support its extensive recovery work following Hurricane Harvey.

Mr. Klein, Of Counsel, ATB, who also volunteered on a Habitat crew working on flooded homes in northeast Houston, presented ATB's donation to the Houston Habitat for Humanity.

Some 30,000 homes in the Houston area reportedly were flooded by Hurricane Harvey; 80 percent of them were not protected by flood insurance. Besides providing low-cost housing, Houston Habitat for Humanity has an ongoing program to help low-income people do needed repairs and renovations. Its 15 on-staff construction managers do the estimating, supervision, and partner with contractors who do the repair work at below-market rates.

In Houston, more than 100 Habitat for Humanity homes were affected by the flooding, and one priority has been to get these clients back on their feet.

The law firm's support of Houston Habitat for Humanity is part of ATB Cares, a national initiative involving each of ATB's 26 offices around the country in various community outreach activities.
